### Variety information

#### Description:

Silver Sport perennial ryegrass was developed by Pure-Seed Testing, Inc., and was bred and selected for its outstanding disease resistance, shade tolerance and spreading capabilities. It is our most elite sports turf variety due to its excellent traffic tolerance, fast establishment and high density. Silver Sport has an appealing dark green color and can withstand the shade better than most perennial ryegrass due to its overall disease resistance and increased tillering.

#### Applications:

Silver Sport is an excellent choice for sports turf managers due to its traffic tolerance, recovery and fast establishment. The high density and dark green color of Silver Sport allow for a pristine playing surface. Silver Sport is resistant to gray leaf spot and has active growth under low light intensities to provide the best turf coverage possible.

#### Geographical Adaption:

Silver Sport is well adapted throughout the cool-season turf grass zones and the northern areas of the transition zone. It thrives in soils with pH from 5.5-8.0. Seeding rates for new home lawns and landscape areas: 7-10 lbs./1,000 sq. ft. (294-490kg./ha). For athletic fields and golf courses in the northern zones, also southern overseeding: 450-650 lbs./acre (204-295kg/ha). Germination can normally be seen in the first week with adequate irrigation and seasonal temperatures. First mowing can occur at any height beyond 1" (2.5cm). Caution to not cut off more than one-third of total height of plant at any mowing.
