





Xeric is a strong creeping red fescue developed by Pure-Seed Testing, Inc. that was selected for improved drought, heat tolerance. This cultivar performs very well at different mowing heights. Xeric is qualified by the Turfgrass Water Conservation Alliance for its improved drought tolerance and good summer turf performance in trials throughout the United States.

Geographical Adaption:

The drought and heat tolerance of Xeric allow for a wider area of adaptation compared to other fine fescues. Seeding rates for lawns and general use: 3-5 lbs./1,000 sq. ft.(195 kg./ha) Golf and reclamation: 150-225 lbs./acre.(170-250 kg/ha) Establishment to be expected in 14-21 days under normal conditions.

Applications:

Xeric is a solid performer on its own and as component in fine fescue blends. It can also be utilized in a sun and shade lawn mixtures with perennial ryegrass and Kentucky bluegrass. Xeric is well adapted for use in erosion control areas such as slopes and steep banks. It is a popular choice by architects and superintendents for links mixes and golf course roughs. Xeric's low maintenance qualities make it an excellent option for ground cover along roadsides.
